### – Sightseeing Highlights in and around Wiesbaden –



The Kurhaus Wiesbaden offers the ideal location for galas and events with its twelve magnificent halls and salons. You will also find in the immediate vicinity of the Hessian State Theater with the departments opera, ballet, drama, young State Theater and concerts.

The Evangelical Market Church, directly at the Dern'sches Gelände (market square) is clad with brick, the diverse design consists of burnt claystone. The main tower has a height of 89 meters and therefore the tallest building in Wiesbaden.



Already in the days of emperor Wilhelm, the two little yellow and blue mountain railway carriages romped up and down Wiesbaden's local mountain. The sophisticated technology inspires – then and now. Since 1888 it has been conquering the Neroberg without incidents.

One of the most visible highlights on the Neroberg is the Russian church, the most beautiful and in its equipment valuable religious building of the city of Wiesbaden. Responsible for this construction was the architect Philipp Hoffmann, who occupied himself during a trip through Russia with Russian architecture.



The Wiesbaden Museum is the state museum for art and nature in the Hessian capital.
